

Geelong Medical Imaging (GMI) makes patient examination data (reports and images) available to all referring health practitioners via its dedicated iSite Web Server.

It is a condition of use that all health practitioners who choose to utilise this system in order to access any patient data agree to abide by the conditions of use as set out below:

- By entering the GMI iSite website and logging in you agree to access the system and the information contained therein for appropriate and justified patient care purposes only.
- You agree that your use of the system will be in accordance with and not in any way infringe or violate the principles and the requirements of both the GMI Privacy Policy and the Health Records Act (Vic) 2001 (as amended)
- You agree not to share your user name or password and to take reasonable steps to protect it from accidental disclosure to others.
- You agree and accept that any and all use of the GMI iSite web server made under your user name and password may be deemed to have been made by you, whether carried out by your employees or others to whom you may have disclosed your user name and password.
- You agree and accept that any and all use of the GMI iSite web server is in relation to a bona fide practitioner/patient relationship that exists in regard to all data you access.
- You agree and accept that GMI can and will make random audits of access and use records pertaining to the iSite system including audits relating to any individual access to any patient record.
- You agree and accept that in the event any such audit indicates access that in the sole opinion of GMI may be irregular, GMI may approach you to confirm the existence of practitioner/patient relationships having existed at the time and date indicated by the audit results and that you will confirm such a relationship to the satisfaction of GMI.
- You agree and accept that in the event of such irregular audit results and subsequent enquiry to you, that if GMI cannot be satisfied of the existence of a practitioner/patient relationship existing at the time and date indicated by the access records, GMI may, at its sole discretion;
 - Suspend or Terminate your access to the GMI iSite system
and/or
 - Inform the Office of the Health Services Commissioner (Vic)
and/or
 - Inform any other professional body as it sees fit to further investigate the matter
